

Reporting Your Concerns

Every UCSF employee should report possible noncompliance with, or violation of, the UCSF Compliance Program. We take these reports seriously and encourage you to contact your Manager, the Compliance Office, or to use the University's hotline at 1-800-403-4744 or universityofcalifornia.edu/hotline [1]. The University has established this hotline, which is independently operated to help ensure confidentiality, for reporting concerns and allegations of suspected improper governmental activities.

Under California law and University policy, members of the campus community, and others, are encouraged to report concerns and allegations of suspected improper governmental activities within the University. UCSF has established policies and procedures for appropriately managing such reports and investigating reported allegations.
